Sclerotherapy is, along with thermal ablation and phlebectomy, one of the 3 main treatments for superficial venous insufficiency. It is the only treatment that can be used regardless of the type of varicose vein (saphenous, tributary, perforating, post-surgical recurrences, perineal veins etc.). Its effectiveness has considerably improved with the use of foam and safety with ultrasound guidance. However, it is a technique that requires a relatively long learning period to be fully mastered.

The new recommendations from the ANSM and vascular societies have led us to modify our practice.

During this workshop, you will learn how to treat your patients with these new constraints, without compromising on effectiveness or tolerance. There will be no loss of luck for your patients, quite the contrary!

Incompetent perforators are often the cause of recurrent varicose veins when they have not been diagnosed or when their role in the pathophysiology of a varicose vein has been poorly assessed. This is understandable as there are a large number of perforators and an ultrasound examination of each perforator is not feasible in current practice. Their treatment is often carried out as a second-line treatment, hence the importance of follow-up and also of having given the patient information about this possibility during the initial examination. This workshop will provide a reminder of the anatomy but above all, through clinical cases and cartographies, it will be possible to better understand the physiopathology of perforators and thus to better identify those that may be the cause of varicose recurrence. The different types of treatment will also be discussed.
